Immunizations in Lancaster County

MUSC Hollings Cancer Center's Community Health Van will be in Lancaster County on April 23-24 to offer HPV, Tdap and meningitis vaccinations to middle and high school students who are VFC-eligible. Parental consent is required. Walk-ins also accepted with parental consent.

Children are eligible for VFC until they turn 19, if they meet one or more of the following criteria: Medicaid-eligible | Uninsured | Under-insured | American Indian or Alaskan Native

What Parents Need to Know about HPV Vaccination

- The HPV vaccine is FDAapproved and extremely safe and effective.
- The HPV vaccine is for both boys and girls. The optimal age for the first dose is 11–12, but it can be given as early as 9.
- Your child only needs 2 doses if vaccination is initiated before age 15.
- The HPV vaccine is long lasting and protects against 6 types of cancer.
