



**What: Character Parade**

We encourage students to dress as their favorite literature character. Participation in dressing up is voluntary. Below are guidelines to ensure appropriate attire and safety for our event:

- No dangerous objects at school (i.e. toy swords, toy guns, chains, skates, light sabers, or spray cans) –Leave those items at home for the Halloween evening fun!
- Students should wear school clothes under the costume or have regular school clothes to change into if needed.
- Costumes should not be scary or frightening. Please make sure your costume doesn't have the following: gore, blood, open wounds, scary clowns or frightening characters are prohibited
- Costumes should be appropriate length (not too short, too tight, or see-through) and must be tasteful--avoid political or gang affiliation.
- Costumes should not include things on the hands or face that would interfere with sight or the learning process. They should not be distracting in class.
- Shoes must be safe (Regular dress code applies -no flip flops, slippers, or high heels)
- Students may wear full cover face masks only during the parade.
- Makeup and Hair color is permitted on this day.
- Make sure your costume is child appropriate!
- Please leave candy at home—encourage healthy food choices!
